Diversity, Equity & Inclusion (DEI) Committee Co-Chairs: Sharon Sunkel / Rudy Roberts Celebrates the uniqueness of each individual REALTOR® within an inclusive and welcoming environment. DRAR recognizes the diversity of our community and seeks to appreciate the differences among our REALTORS®, staff and to promote all voices.

Durham Public Schools Education Committee Chair: Coleen Ellis
